The CAC has been working hard this year to understand the concerns of the community and provide advice to the University Endowment Lands.

Recently, the CAC met with Minister Robinson, Deputy Minister Krishna and Assistant Deputy Minister Faganello to discuss our issues including the concern about the Block F, UEL Community Centre which will soon be built. Members of our community where under the impression that the developers of Block F committed to covering the first FOUR years of operational costs for the community centre. This commitment was critical to the arrangement given that leading consultants have advised that such community centres run operation deficits of \$400,000 to \$1million per year. Apparently, this commitment by the developers was not formalized. We addressed this with the Minister and she has agreed to investigate this matter.
